WHAT IS LCN TOENAIL RECONSTRUCTION?

The LCN (Light Cured Nail) product, Wilde-Pedique gel, mimics the appearance and texture of a natural toenail once it is applied and cured. This UV gel is highly flexible and solidifies under UVA light exposure. Primarily designed for therapeutic toenail procedures, this gel resin can adhere to surfaces, enhance durability, and dry with a glossy sheen. Additionally, it can flexibly adjust to toe movements.

WHO IS THIS TREATMENT FOR?

Clients seeking a cosmetically pleasing solution to prevent nail snagging and infection can benefit from a prosthetic nail. It requires refilling every 4-6 weeks until the toenail fully grows. The prosthetic nail can be treated like a normal toenail, cut, painted, and used with products like UV gels. It does not dissolve with acetone and must be professionally removed after 6-8 weeks or refilled as the natural nail grows.

Considerations for LCN Toenail reconstruction:

- Fungal treatment complements fungal nail treatment, aiming to contain spread and boost confidence.
- Prosthetic nails help damaged nails grow properly to reduce ingrown nail risks.
- Treatment for cracked or split nails prevents further damage.
